Confirmation of Cardel Hi Bond 3, Hi Bond 70-1, Hi Bond 70B (Black) and Hi Bond 2 compliance with the latest REACH regulation, SVHC – List

Dear Customer,

By this written declaration Cardel confirms that Cardel products including specifically Hi Bond 3, Hi Bond 70-1, Hi Bond 70B (Black) and Hi Bond 2 contain less than 0.1% of the restricted substances present in the Candidate list published on June 25th 2020 and are therefore compliant with the REACH and SVHC list of 209 substances.

The list published in June 2020 identified four new specific substances of very high concern as below:

Substances currently identified as being a SVHC on the Candidate list of Substances of Very High Concern for authorisation, last update 25.6.2020 and containing 209 substances **are not used in the production of the products manufactured by Cardel** listed above and are therefore not contained.

The presence of analytically detectable traces of such substances, which occur widely and might potentially have been introduced into our products via the raw materials, auxiliaries and additives used in our manufacturing cannot be excluded. The level of such substances is confirmed to be below 0.1%
